

Was wondering if drones are allowed in Doheny State Beach. I have tried researching for specific rules and/or ordinance online for the State Beach and the City of Dana Point but could not find anything current. Any information would be greatly appreciated. This is for recreational use and I am familiar with all FAA regulations. Cay

The recreational use of drones in Doheny State Beach is not permitted due to the possibility of injury to the general public, as well as avoiding the annoyance factor to people enjoying a day at the beach and in the park.

When I made the reservation over the phone I was told [our site] was definitely a tent camping spot, but after going through some of the pictures online, I'm not sure if that's actually the case. I was hoping you guys might have some additional details/specs on it so I know if the tent we have will fit. I just called [ReserveCalifornia] to get some additional details, but they said all that was showing on their end was that the length of the pad is 17' and no width was displayed. Corey

I understand the confusion. ReserveCalifornia classifies campsites a little differently than we do; they consider any site that does not have hookups to be a tent campsite. Thus... Doheny is a 'tent' campground. We, of course, allow RV's and motorhomes in the campground. The site you asked about is a dual wide site, 18' deep on both sides. It has a tent area big enough for a medium-sized tent (small being classified as a 4-person). Let me know if you have other questions regarding the site.
