SUMMER ARRIVES JUNE 21st: The June Solstice at Doheny is on Monday, June 21st at **8:54 AM PDT**. It is when the Northern Hemisphere of Earth is turned to its greatest degree towards the sun. For us, this will be the longest day of sunlight and the shortest of darkness. The days (time of sunlight) will start getting shorter now. As for our friends in the Southern Hemisphere, they are celebrating their first day of winter.

I'm looking to do a small picnic in June and I was wondering if you have any free (first come-first serve) picnic areas? Shannon

Yes, barbecues and smaller picnic tables are available on the northern (harbor) side of the Park, closest to the beach, and are first-come first-serve. All of our covered picnic areas are available for advanced reservation through our Events Coordinator, Denise Estrada. Unreserved covered picnic areas are available on

a first-come first-serve basis, which varies day by day. A list of currently reserved picnic areas is displayed on the front of the Kiosk as you enter the park. You may enter the park as early as 6 AM to see which tables are currently unreserved, but please know that tables must be claimed by at least one individual who remains at the site—items left alone at a table will be removed by our maintenance staff.

Does the park allow for RV trailer day use? I have a pop-up trailer and would like to use on a Saturday day trip with the family. I'm not looking for a camping spot. Ricardo

Yes, pop-up trailers are allowed within the parking lot. We do ask, however, that you do not extend any awnings or partitions outside of your parking spot and do not set up any furniture within the parking lot. If your RV or trailer is over 25', you will need to pay an oversized vehicle fee of \$30 to park for the day.
