He would surf, dive for lobster and abalone, catch fish from his paddle board, become Doheny's first lifeguard and live in the park in his panel truck, well into his 90s. He was the best surfer in the water, not because he was that good, but because he was the guy having the most fun. Celebrate Pop's 138th birthday by raising a glass of Italian red wine, his favorite.

WINTER SOLSTICE: Winter begins on Saturday, December 21st at 8:19 PM local time. In terms of daylight, this day is 4-hours and 19-minutes shorter than the first day of summer last June. In most locations north of the equator, the shortest day of the year is around this date. Our shortest day of the year will be on December 22nd. It will be less than 1 second shorter than the day before.

1) Can I use a generator? Yes, generators are allowed from 10 AM to 8 PM every dav.

2) Can I put a 24-ft. travel trailer on a 20-ft. pad? No, you will not be able to fit in the spot as the tongue of the trailer will stick out into the road. This would result in you receiving a citation. There are multiple sites that will accommodate up to a 40.5foot motor home. Site 38 is our largest and will accommodate a 65-ft. RV.
