HOW TO SUPPORT DSBIA AND THE PARK PROGRAMS WE FUND



FIRST DAY OF SUMMER: Summer begins Saturday, June 20th at 2:44 PM Pacific Daylight Time. This is the day and time when the rotation and axis tilt of the earth puts the sun directly above the equator as it moves higher in the sky through the northern hemisphere. It gives us our longest day of the year in terms of sunlight and shortest night. We gain one second from the previous day and will lose one second on the following day as the amount of sun each day begins to grow shorter. For our friends in the southern hemisphere, this is their first day of winter.



SUNRISE / SUNSET:

June 1st: Sunrise @ 5:41 AM / Sunset @ 7:51 PM = 14 hrs. 10 mins. 27 secs. of sun We gain 0 mins. & 50 secs. of sun from the previous day.

June 20th: Sunrise @ 5:41 AM / Sunset @ 7:59 PM = 14 hrs. 18 mins. 25 secs. of sun We gain 0 mins. & 1 sec of sun from the previous day.

June 30th: Sunrise @ 5:44AM / Sunset @ 8:00PM = 14 hrs. 16 mins. 13 secs. of sun.

We lost 0 mins. & 26 secs. of sun from the previous day.

Gained minutes of sun this month: 0 hrs. 39 mins. 50 secs.

June Moon Phases: Full: 5th Last Quarter: 12th New (No) Moon: 20th First Quarter: 28th

BE A VOLUNTEER IN THE VISITOR CENTER: Visitors love our aquarium and displays in the V.C., but volunteer docents are essential to keeping our doors open. There's plenty of support with Association Coordinator Kathy, Interpreter Vicki and Aquarist Bill, as well as the help of your fellow docents. We ask for a commitment of 6-hours a month, that's one day's shift, and shifts can be split 3-hours. Come on in, it's fun and you meet nice people.
