

They are lightweight enough to blow away in the wind and fragile enough to crunch like cornflakes underfoot. Can you tell me what they are? Susan

Had to go to an expert on this one, retired park Supervising Ranger Jim Serpa, who said, "Most of them are Bubble Shells, the favorite food of the beautiful slug <u>Navanax</u>. The other, I'm pretty sure, is a snail called <u>Orbitestella diegensis</u> (no common name) and is usually found under

gravel near kelp. There are a couple others it could be but they are both white so probably not.
